The island unit is the focal point of this kitchen, functioning both stylistically and practically, as it doubles as an area for food preparation, as well as for casual dining.



Caesarstone's Emperadoro black quartz has been chosen for the worktops. The deeply toned material contrasts with the light cabinetry, adding visual interest and allowing the paler shades to shine.

Tom Howley's Barnet kitchen uses a neutral colour to create the illusion of light and space. Exposed appliances, including Neff ovens and a Sub-Zero fridge freezer and wine cooler, work with the dark flooring, worktops and upstand, to ensure the space retains its aesthetic appeal. 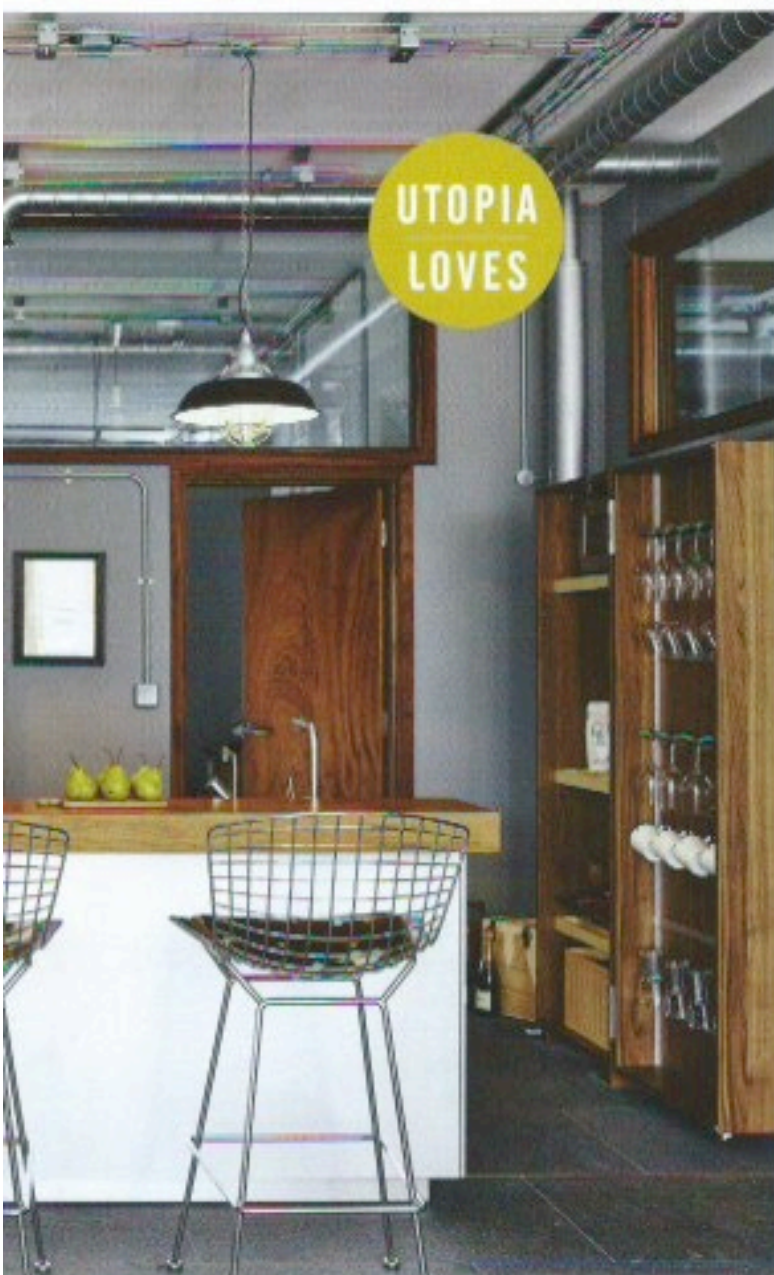
