The high-tech machine offers personalisation of mineral content for each user, as well as offering the option of still, sparkling, cold, ambient, or hot water. Water is purified using reverse osmosis before minerals are added to suit an individual's taste. The dispenser

utilises a smart bottle system enabling it to remember the preferred settings linked to each bottle. It has been designed for use in a range of applications, including workplaces, hospitality, and sports and leisure.
