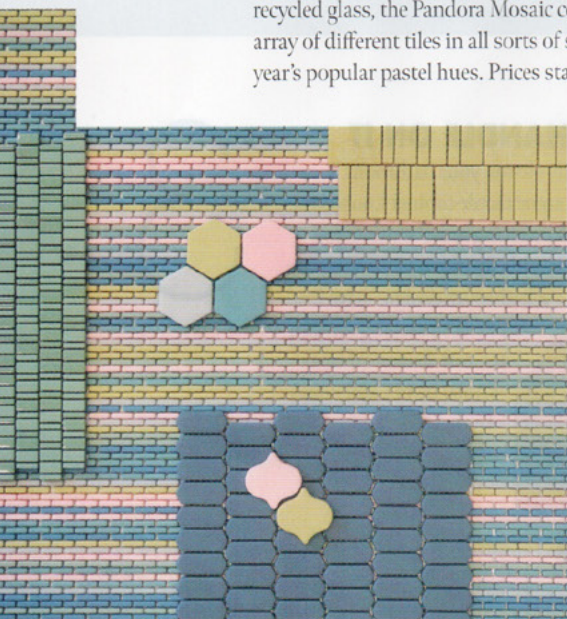
## CHECKING IN
